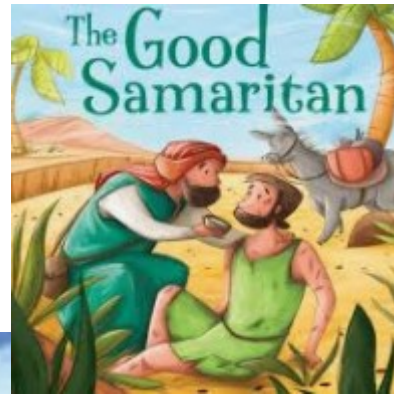


2.4 What kind of world did Jesus want?

Key Vocabulary

Fishers of people—someone who tells the stories of Jesus to encourage them to live with love and forgiveness.

Parable—a story in the bible
